The child's support network at school



The learning specialist **assesses** and **works** with students who have **learning difficulties**.

The psychologist is consulted when a student experiences **emotional** or **behavioral difficulties**.

The psychoeducator is a specialist in supporting students with **adjustment** and **adaptation problems**.

The teacher plays a key role in **supporting** a child with ADHD.

The school administration plays a role similar to the teacher and **supervises** the intervention plan.
